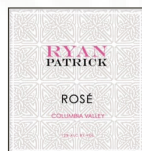
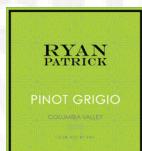
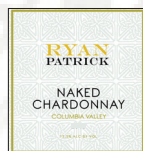

CORE WINES

2019 Naked Chardonnay

An unoaked Chardonnay with a refreshing entry, a creamy, fruit driven mid-palate and an elegant, pleasing finish. Ripe pear and apple flavors with a hint of lily and lemongrass.

2019 Riesling

A pleasing, round entry with fresh acidity, a fruit driven mid-palate and a clean, refreshing finish. White peach, ripe pear and orange blossom, with hints of fresh apples and mineral undertones.

2019 Pinot Grigio

Sourced from cooler climate vineyards in Ancient Lakes of the Columbia Valley (50%) and Horse Heaven Hills (50%). Fermented in stainless steel tanks for ten months, our Pinot Grigio expresses bright floral notes, minerality and citrus including nectarine and mango. Nice viscosity on the mid-palate with a crisp finish.

2019 Sauvignon Blanc

Fermented and aged in stainless steel to accentuate fruit intensity. Floral, citrus, peach and nectarine flavors. A crisp, dry mouthfeel with a subtle viscosity. 100% Sauvignon Blanc.

2018 Redhead Red

A blend of 26% Cabernet Sauvignon, 26% Merlot, 26% Syrah, 14% Sangiovese and 8% Grenache. Bing cherry, blackberry, black raspberry, jammy notes with soft, round tannins and a lingering finish. Aged 24 months: 78% stainless steel tanks, 22% American oak barrels.

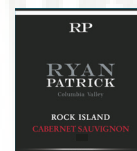
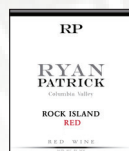
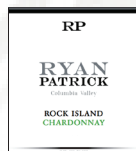
2020 Rosé

Wonderful citrus notes of grapefruit and lemon are complimented with floral aromas. Crisp mouthfeel and finish. Aged on lees for three months in stainless steel tanks. 50% Sangiovese, 19% Syrah, 16% Grenache, 12% Mourvedre, 3% Cinsault. Pack: 12/750ml; UPC: 8 51057-00017 4

2018 Rock Island Chardonnay

A ripe and full mid-palate with tropical flavors complemented by hints of vanilla. Aged 7 months - 40% French oak, 60% stainless steel. Pack: 12/750ml; UPC: 8 51057-00000 6

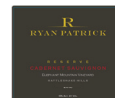
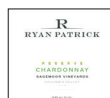
2018 Rock Island Red

39% Syrah, 30% Malbec, 17% Merlot, 14% Cabernet Sauvignon. Dark fruit of black cherry, blackberry, and plum are accented with hints of vanilla, dark roasted coffee, and dark chocolate. After a very concentrated entry and mid-palate, the flavors persist on the palate for an extended finish. Aged 25 months: 70% barrel aged in American oak (10% new barrels), 30% aged in stainless steel tanks. Pack: 12/750ml; UPC: 8 51057-00006 8

2017 Rock Island Cabernet Sauvignon

75% Cabernet Sauvignon, 14% Merlot, 11% Syrah from the Columbia Valley. Initial hit of vanilla and toasted oak spice. Deep, dark black fruit like black currants, plum, and blackberry jam. Rich, concentrated mouthfeel on the mid-palate with a spicy black pepper finish. Aged 30 months in 20% new American oak barrels.

RESERVE WINES

2017 Reserve Chardonnay

Columbia Valley's Sagemoor Vineyards create a Chardonnay with bright ripe pear, apple, papaya and mango flavors with subdued notes of toasted oak and vanilla. Refreshing acidity, rich mid-palate and lingering finish. Eleven months of French oak. 224 cases produced.

2017 Reserve Syrah

Capturing the terroir of Red Heaven Vineyard, Red Mountain with dark berries and hints of coffee on the mid-palate with a dense tannin structure and a generous finish. 18 months of French oak. 200 cases produced.

2018 Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon

Showcasing the distinctive style of Elephant Mountain Vineyard in Yakima Valley's Rattlesnake Hills, this wine has intense aromatics of black currants, black cherries and fig. Some upfront lactones followed by baking spice and kirsch. Very concentrated mouthfeel with lush tannins, slight herbaceousness, and an extremely long finish. Aged 17 months in French and American oak barrels.
