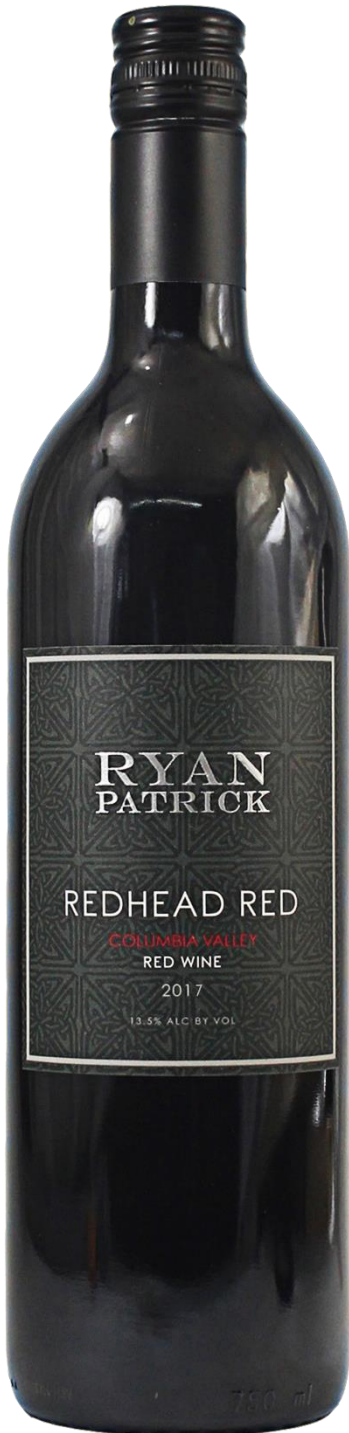


# RYAN PATRICK

## 2017 REDHEAD RED

**AVA:** 100% Columbia Valley

**VINEYARDS:** Clifton Hill, Ravens Cliff, Northridge (Wahluke Slope).  
Alderdale Farms (Horse Heaven Hills).  
Art Denhoed (Columbia Valley).



**WINEMAKING NOTES:** The grapes were gently destemmed and allowed to cold soak in the tank prior to inoculation with yeast strains selected to emphasize terroir and varietal character. Once fermentation began (in stainless steel tanks) the grapes were pumped over twice daily to aid in the extraction of color and tannin. After about seven days, the free run wine was drained away from the grapes and sent to barrel for malolactic fermentation.

**WINEMAKER COMMENTS:** “An approachable red blend with rich and ripe flavors. We source fruit from vineyards throughout the Columbia Valley emphasizing backbone and depth, characteristics intrinsic to the style of our Redhead Red.” – Kendall Mix, Winemaker

**TASTING NOTES:**

**AROMA:** Black cherry and ripe raspberry with dark chocolate, savory herb and red currant.

**FLAVOR:** A juicy entry with a plush midpalate and a long fruit driven finish.

**VARIETAL(S):** 59% Cabernet Sauvignon, 14% Mourvedre, 12% Syrah, 9% Grenache, 6% Malbec.

**DATE OF HARVEST:** September-October 2017.

**BOTTLED:** July 2018.

**ALCOHOL:** 13.5 %

**BRIX:** 24.5%

**TA:** (g/L): 5.40

**PH:** 3.81

**AGING:** 15% new American oak for seven months.
