**TASTING NOTES**

**AROMA:** Expressive notes of fresh dark roasted coffee, black cherry, black currants, vanilla bean, nutmeg, blackberry, and slight tanned leather.

**FLAVOR:** Very concentrated on the palate; big, dense mouthfeel with moderate tannin. Black currants, black cherry, roasted chestnuts, nutmeg, and dark roasted coffee flavors.

**VARIETAL(S):** 100% Cabernet Sauvignon
