AVA: Columbia Valley

VINEYARDS: Katherine Leone, Wahluke Slope, Ravenscliff, High River

WINEMAKING NOTES: The grapes were harvested in the early morning and went directly to press upon arrival. The juice was drained from the skins before too much color or tannin was imparted, and then cold settled. After racking off the solids, the juice was inoculated and allowed to ferment slowly for approximately 30 days, until the proper residual sugar/acid balance was achieved; at which point the juice underwent an extended cool fermentation to stabilize the wine.

TASTING NOTES

AROMA: Hints of lavender, strawberry, and slight citrus.

FLAVOR: Bright, lively acidity. Crisp mouthfeel with notes of strawberry, red cherry, and grapefruit.

VARIETAL(S): 41% Syrah, 33% Tempranillo, 24% Mourvèdre, 1% Grenache, 1% Sangiovese

DATE OF HARVEST: September 9 – September 11, 2019

BOTTLED: January 13, 2020

ALCOHOL: 13% **TA(gal/L):** 5.9 **pH:** 3.29 **RS:** 0.20%

AGING: Aged three months in stainless steel tanks.
