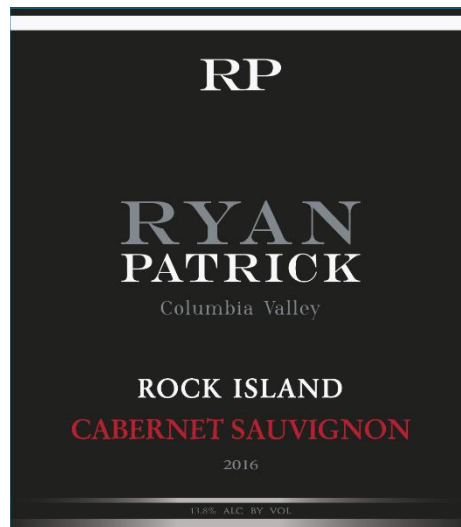


# RYAN PATRICK

## 2016 Rock Island Cabernet Sauvignon



**AVA:** Columbia Valley

**SUB AVA'S & VINEYARDS:** **Wahluke Slope** – Clifton Vineyard, Rosebud Vineyard, King Fuji Vineyard, Hawk Vineyard, and Pheasant Vineyard  
**Snipes Mountain** – Newhouse Vineyard  
**Yakima Valley** – Den Hoed Vineyard

**WINEMAKING NOTES:** Grapes were selected from several vineyards across the Columbia Valley, providing a range of different sites, then when blended create greater nuance and complexity. 50% was barrel aged, which helps to soften and round the mouthfeel, the other 50% was aged in stainless steel, which helps to preserve the fruit character.

### TASTING NOTES

**AROMA:** Notes of Bing and black cherry, slight hint of vanilla, and coffee, with some darker fruit aspect of black currant, an interesting hint of HB pencil lead, and slight herbaciousness on the finish.

**FLAVOR:** Very nice rounded mouthfeel on the entry; black cherry, and black berry through midpalate, with a touch of oak baking spice, some minerality and pencil lead on finish.

**VARIETAL(S):** 83% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Merlot, 2% Malbec

**DATE OF HARVEST:** September 18, 2016 – November 11, 2016

**BOTTLED:** June 2019    **ALCOHOL:** 13.8%    **TA:** 6.0 g/L    **pH:** 3.74

**AGING:** Aged 22 months – 50% in American oak barrels and 50% in stainless steel
